## **APA Format Guide**

## **General Rules**

- 1. All text should be double-spaced.
- 2. Numbers 10 and above should be expressed in digits, while numbers nine and below should be expressed in words. The exception to this rule is that digits should be used in contexts such as measurement (3.25 cm), percentages (9%), fractions (4/4), times (5:00 PM), ages (8 years old), money (\$5), or when referring to part of a book or article (Chapter 4, Illustration 1). Titles, sentences, or text headings that begin with a number should be written out if unable to reword.
- 3. Statistical symbols  $(F, p, r, X^2, \text{ etc.})$  should be italicized. The exception is Greek letters, which are not italicized.
